Selous Game Reserve

Is larger than Switzerland in size and is the most pristine wilderness remaining in Africa. It consists of a wide variety of wildlife habitats. These include open grasslands, acacia and Miombo woodlands, swamps, and forests along the numerous tributaries of the Rufiji River flowing through the reserve.

Home of the largest population of elephants in any East African Natural Reserve. There are over 10,000 species that can be seen throughout this National Park.
