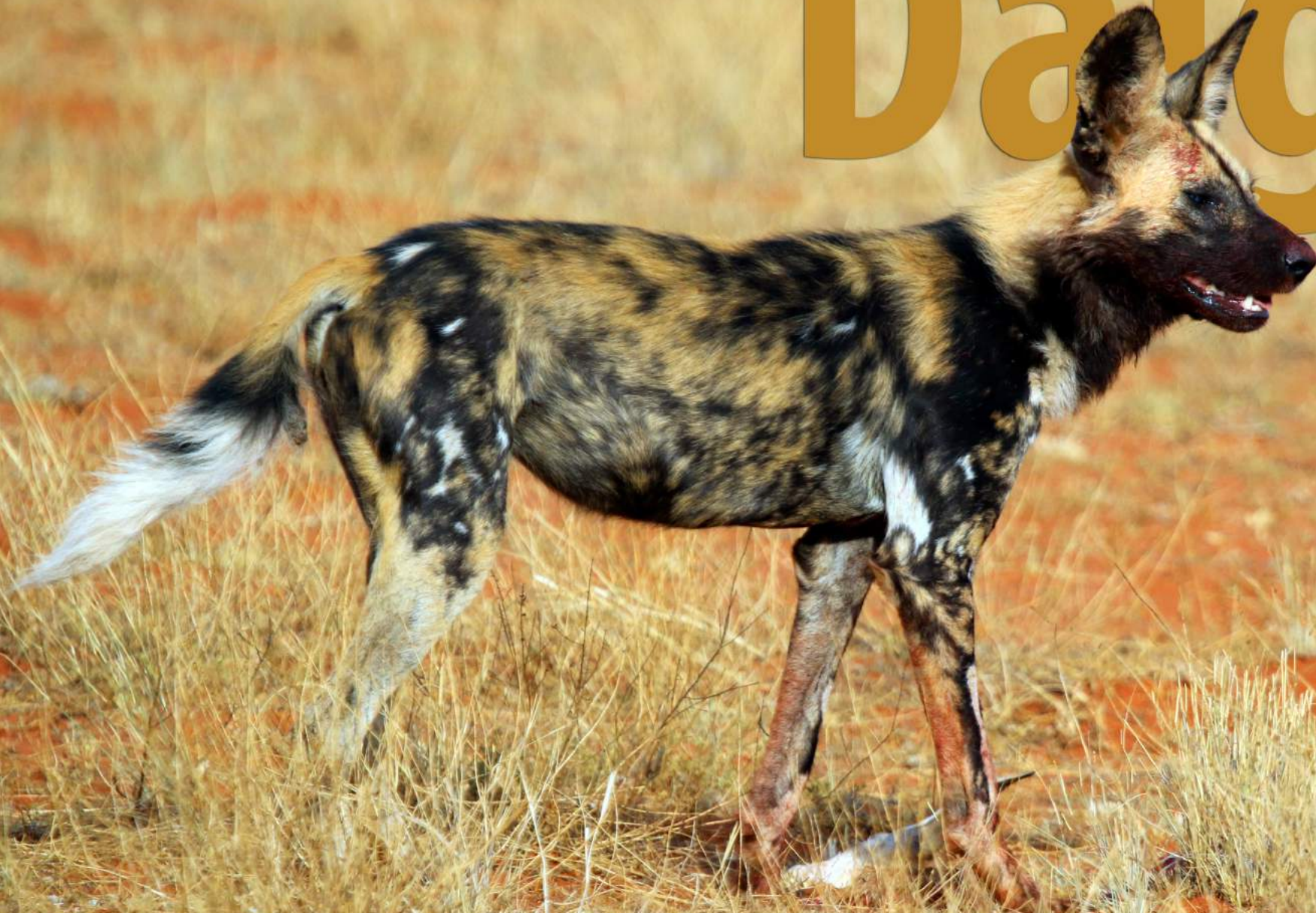

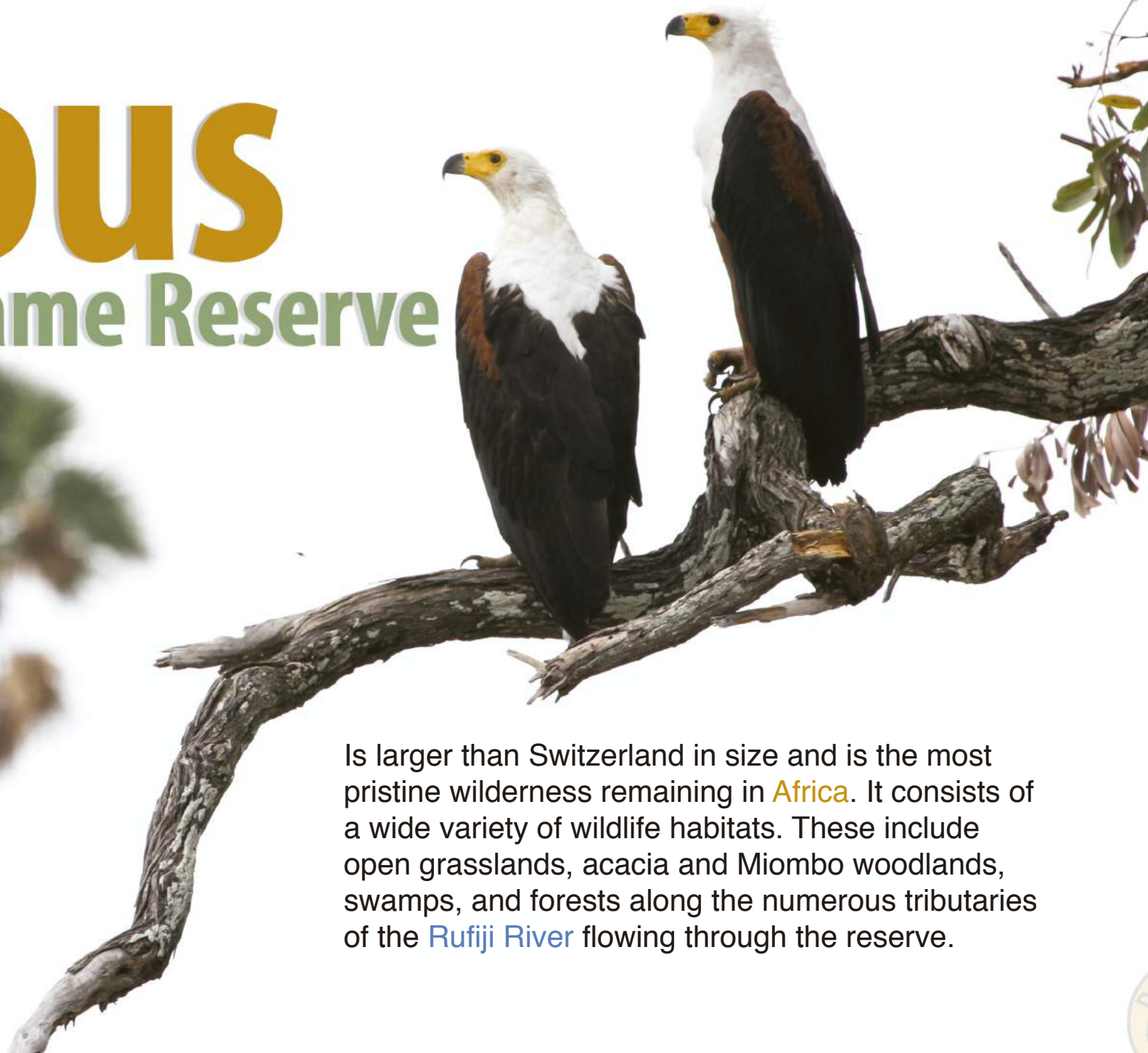

# Selous

## Game Reserve



Is larger than Switzerland in size and is the most pristine wilderness remaining in [Africa](#). It consists of a wide variety of wildlife habitats. These include open grasslands, acacia and Miombo woodlands, swamps, and forests along the numerous tributaries of the [Rufiji River](#) flowing through the reserve.



# Ruaha

## National Park

Home of the largest population of elephants in any **East African** Natural Reserve. There are over 10,000 species that can be seen throughout this **National Park**.





# Mikumi

## National Park

Is located in the north of the **Selous Game Reserve** in the Morogoro region. Elephants, giraffes, zebras, elands, kudu, wildebeest, and antelope are some of the wildlife you will find, plus a large bird variety; more than **400** different species.







# Udzungwa Mountains National Park

One of only thirty-four “[World Biodiversity Hotspots](#)”. This range of mountains start from the Taita Hills in Southern Kenya to the Makambako Gap in south central of [Tanzania](#). This high biodiversity makes it one of the most incredible places in the [World](#).



# Kilwa

## Heritage Site

The remains of two great [East African](#) ports admired by early European explorers are situated on two small islands near the coast. From the 13th to the 16th century, the merchants of [Kilwa](#) dealt in gold, silver, pearls, perfumes, Arabian crockery, Persian earthenware and Chinese porcelain; most of the trade in the [Indian Ocean](#) passed through their hands.
